The Free Trade Agreements agreements with European Union

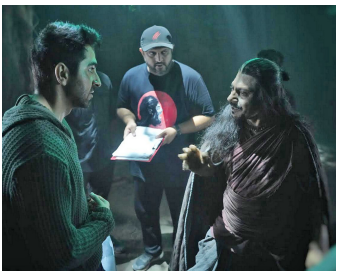

Ahmedabad, International Road Federation (IRF), has welcomed the recent circular issued by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) introducing a framework for rating contractors and concessionaires working on National Highway projects. In a communication addressed to V. Umashankar, Secretary , Union Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) Mr. K. K. Kapila, President Emeritus of the International Road Federation (IRF) complimented the Ministry for issuing the circular dated 3 February 2026, describing it as a step in the right direction that will bring greater transparency, accountability and professionalism among contracting agencies involved in highway development. "The circular provides a

comprehensive evaluation mechanism, assigning scores across various parameters to assess the performance of contractors and concessionaires engaged in National Highway projects. He said such a system will help improve scrutiny and performance monitoring of agencies responsible for critical infrastructure development" said Mr Kapila. However, he suggested that the guidelines would become more effective if they clearly specify how the performance scores will be used during the award of future projects. According to Mr. Kapila, the award of works should be aligned with the provisions of the General Financial Rules (GFR) issued by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, to ensure fairness, transparency and optimal use of public resources. A 3-year-old child has been shifted for treatment after his health deteriorated after drinking the juice. Everyone was shocked when the father opened the tetra pack and checked it in the hospital and found an insect larger than half an inch. The child's father has demanded action in this matter.

The health of a 3-year-old child deteriorated after drinking a tetra pack.

The child's father, Arvind Parmar, said that he had taken a tetra pack around 7:30 to 8 pm yesterday evening. The expiry date of which was in May. The child drank some. He asked to pour it into a glass. Later, when he poured it into the glass, a black liquid and a foul smell came out. Later, the family became suspicious and immediately reached SSG Hospital.

A dead insect was found while opening the Tretapack in the hospital.

When the doctors asked to check the packing, the doctors and parents were shocked to find a large insect in it. The child has been immediately kept under observation in the

ICU due to the fear of any toxic effects. The doctors have asked to keep him under observation for 48 to 72 hours. If the child had drunk the entire bottle, the result would have been very bad. Buy only transparent bottles when giving cold drinks to children - Father The father of the child appealed to other parents through Divya Bhaskar that while giving cold drinks to children, instead of closed bottles, let them drink in transparent bottles or glasses so that the inside is clearly visible. transparent so that the inside is visible and keep the expiry

date at least - like milk which is 2-3 days.
