Elected govt must be respected, not undermined: J&K Deputy CM

Srinagar, June 12 (UND): Deputy Chief Minister of Jammu and Kashmir, Surinder Kumar Choudhary voiced serious concerns over what he termed as re-created undermining of the elected government by the office of the Lieutenant Governor. He asserted that the government in J&K is one “made from the hearts of the people” and not a nominated or appointed one. Referring to recent administrative decisions and transfers, the Deputy CM warned that such actions damaged the spirit of Indian democracy. “We hoped that the LG sahib would accept the mandate of the people and will understand and accord-

celebrate that I have done a lot of bravery,” Choudhary told reporters in Srinagar. Drawing parallels with the freedom struggle, he invoked the sacrifices of Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, and Sukhdev, questioning whether ignoring the democratic mandate amounted to reverting to colonial-era practices. “If elected representatives are not allowed to take decisions, what difference remains between us and the British?” he asked. The deputy CM said that when the government is elected by the people, then the elected government should get the full right to make those decisions in the interest of the people.



Officers or the LG. "When the LG visits, roads are sealed and forces are deployed. But we go among our people without fear, because we serve them," he said.

He also praised Chief Minister Omar Abdullah, describing him as "a polished and down-to-earth leader" whose leadership could greatly benefit J&K in the current term. "Even if someone tries to crush the people's mandate, they will fail. We are protected by the

people and by God,” he added. The deputy CM warned that continued interference with the elected government’s functioning could force representatives to take to the streets in protest. “We are not afraid.... We are here to face challenges, and if necessary, we will fight for our people by taking to the streets. Right now, we are quiet because we are in the government. But if someone wants to push us out, we will not back down,” he said.

Srinagar sizzles as mercury hits 34.2°C

Srinagar, June 12 (UNI): Kashmir continued to sizzle, with Srinagar recording a maximum temperature of 34.2°C, the Meteorological Centre Srinagar said. The MeT has predicted mainly dry and hot weather conditions across Jammu and Kashmir in the next two days, with a possibility of isolated rain or thunderstorms in some areas. Several areas on Thursday recorded daytime temperatures 5°C to 7°C above normal. Srinagar registered a scorching 34.2°C, which is 6.2°C above normal, while Qazigund in south Kashmir witnessed 33.9°C, a sharp 7.2°C above average. The popular tourist destination Pahalgam wasn't spared either, recording 29.0°C, 5.3°C above normal. In other parts of the valley, the border area of Kupwara touched 33.0°C (+4.8°C), Kokernag reached 33.2°C (+7.0°C), and even the usually cool Gulmarg saw a high of 24.8°C, which is 6.0°C above normal. The minimum night temperatures were recorded 1°C to 5°C above normal, while in the Jammu division, they were even higher, ranging between 3°C to 6°C above normal. The persistently warm nights have added to the discomfort caused by soaring daytime temperatures. According to the MeT forecast, J&K will continue to experience generally hot and dry conditions until June 13, with a brief respite expected between June 14 and 17, when isolated to scattered places may witness light rain or thundershowers accompanied by gusty winds. The weather is expected to revert to hot and dry from June 18 to 20.

As per the instructions of the District Medical and Health Officer, Deputy Health Education Officer Mohammed Rafi and TB Supervisor Prabhakar, under the leadership of Secretary Uday Mohan Reddy and Convener Bhagya Lakshmi of VELUGU Voluntary Service Organization located in Ammacheruvumitta under Madanapalle Rural, created awareness about TB disease and distributed pamphlets. Speaking on the occasion, Deputy Health Education Officer Mohammed Rafi said



that as part of the 100-day TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyan program, ASHA workers and health workers conducted a door-to-door survey and identified smokers, alcohol drinkers, those who had recovered from TB in the past, HIV positive, those with BMI below 18, pregnant women, those with diabetes, and

those with chronic diseases. They were tested and if they tested positive, six months of treatment would be started free of cost, and Rs. 1000 would be deposited in the patient's account during the treatment. As part of this, 10 TB patients were adopted on behalf of the VELUGU Volunteer Service Organization to

provide nutritious food. VELUGU Social Worker Geetha, Principal of the School for the Gifted and Talented Leena Kumari, TB Unit Staff Suseela, Vanaja, Ashram ANM Geetha, Kollabailu ANM Jyothi, MLHP Sravani, and ASHA activists Nissi Gesi and Reddy Kumari participated in the program.

Jairam slams US invite to Pak Army chief, calls it diplomatic setback for India

New Delhi, June 12 (UNI) Amid reports that Pakistan Army Chief Gen Asim Munir has been invited for the US Army Day on June 14, senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh termed it a "major diplomatic and strategic setback" for India. Talking to X, Ramesh questioned the 'United States' intent, pointing out that General Munir is the same person who made provocative remarks shortly before the Pahalgam



terror attack. He also criticised the recent remarks by the US Central Command

chief, who described Pakistan as a "great partner" in the "counter-terrorism efforts." "The Modi government is saying that Operation Sindoor is still underway; in such a situation, the participation of the Pakistani Army Chief as a guest at the US Army Day event is undoubtedly a matter of serious concern," Ramesh said. The Rajya Sabha MP further said, "The Trump administration is consistently mak-

ing statements that can only be interpreted to mean that the US is viewing India and Pakistan through the same lens. The Prime Minister has only recently welcomed the delegation that had briefed the global community, including the United States, on Pakistan's involvement in supporting terrorism, yet simultaneously, reports from Washington DC are surfacing that further undermine India's diplomatic standing."
