

Farmers' anger in Khambhaliya

Dwarka Khambhaliya, The District Congress has expressed its anger over the farmers not getting regular electricity in the rural areas of Khambhaliya taluka. A large number of farmers, led by Dwarka District Congress Committee President Palbhai Ambalia, surrounded the PGVCL office. Meanwhile, Ambalia showed a banner in his hand, which read, "People say that one signature is in a bottle. Is this true?"

According to the farmers' submission, let alone 8 hours of electricity a day in Vadatra Sub-Division, Khambhaliya Division or Kalyanpur, Dwarka, Bhanvad Division, even after 8 days and 8 nights, they do not get 8 hours of electricity. They alleged that the government's promises of providing 8 hours of electricity a day have proven to be empty. During this submission, the District Congress has sent a letter to the Energy Minister, Agriculture Minister and Chief Minister to apologize to the farmers and provide regular and sufficient electricity.

The District Congress has expressed its anger over the farmers in rural areas of Khambhaliya taluka not getting regular electricity. A large number of farmers, led by Palbhai Amblia, President of Dwarka District Congress Committee, surrounded the PGVCL office.

According to the farmers' submissions, far from the talk of 8 hours of electricity a day in Vadtra Sub-Division, Khambhaliya Division or Kalyanpur, Dwarka, Bhanvad Division, even after 8 days and 8 nights, electricity is not available for 8 hours. In this situation, the government's promises of providing 8 hours of electricity a day have proven to be hollow.

Under the leadership of Devbhoomi Dwarka District

Congress Committee President Palbhai Amblia, farmers from Khambhaliya and surrounding rural areas collectively presented a representation at the PGVCL office here, stating that in Vadtra Sub-Division, Khambhaliya Division or Kalyanpur, Dwarka, Bhanvad Division, let alone 8 hours of electricity a day, electricity is not available for 8 days and 8 nights combined. So on what basis do you make promises and promises of providing electricity for 8 hours a day? The promises of providing electricity should be withdrawn.

Not only this, for the last 13 years in the district, Chanchalana 66 KV and for the last 8 years, Beraja 66 KV have been ready but both of them cannot be used due to the lack of power lines. On the other hand, police protection is provided overnight to remove the power lines of private companies, violating all the rules, JCB machines start running in the standing crops of farmers and police protection is also provided until the power lines are installed. So the question is, where is the difficulty for Jetco or PGVCL in pulling the lines to connect these two 66 KV?? Questions like this have also been asked.

In March ending, with the allegation that Pathani is being collected by PGVCL, they reach the house to collect the electricity bill, then they do not resolve the complaint for three months, saying that there is no man in the complaint regarding electricity. If there are no men and no vehicles, then for checking, several vehicles and all the men who come in them were asked to first send the complaint regarding electricity to resolve it and then come for checking. PGVCL has also been accused of doing corrupt work, except for 0.5%



engineers. In the feeder which has a capacity of 50 TC, 500 TC has been given, so it is natural that the electricity load is bound to arise. Why are they not improving it??? Questions have also been raised as to why there is such an imbalance, as one feeder has a network of 100 kilometers of power lines while the other feeder has only 10 kilometers of power lines.

For the last three decades, wires, cables, etc. have not been replaced. If they have been replaced, they have been replaced only on paper. Due to this, due to the weakening of the electric wires, cables, etc., the power lines frequently break and power interruptions arise. According to the rules, a proper crossing should be provided wherever two power lines pass. Allegations have been made that premonsoon work is done only on paper and no work is done on site.

It was also alleged here that your engineers are thirsty for bottles where one bottle is enough to pay one bill. The feeders of Hanjdapar, Datrana and Bhatel villages have also been mentioned in this letter.

If your own customer gets

an electricity connection due to your own negligence, then the director will come and fine you, and the customers will have to bear the brunt of your mistake? Where is the justice in this? Saying that thousands of maintenance applications are pending and are not being disposed of for months, it has also been alleged that the common man is the victim of PGVCL's negligence and alleged corruption.

First of all, 66 KV Chanchalana and Beraha should be started immediately, wherever there is overload in the feeder, over TC, over length of power lines, it should be balanced with smaller feeders, PGVCL should first follow the rules and then expect the rules from the farmers and citizens, apologize to the farmers for the promises of providing electricity for 8 hours a day, and it has been demanded that farmers should be provided electricity for 8 hours continuously in 24 hours without any problems. New revelations in 1550 crore cyber fraud case

Vrinda, sister of main accused Kirat Jadwani, under suspicion, lookout notice issued

Surat, Shocking revelations have been made in the RBL Bank 1550 crore cyber fraud case. It has been revealed that 8 employees of the bank itself are directly involved in this scam. The sister of the main accused Kirat Jadwani, Vrinda, is also under suspicion, due to which a lookout notice has been issued against her. The police suspect the role of former and current employees of RBL Bank in this investigation. Eight employees

suspended The revelation of a cyber fraud worth Rs 1550 crore from Surat city has created a stir. While investigating the matter in depth, the Udhna police have made many shocking revelations. It has been revealed that not only cyber criminals but also bank employees are directly involved in this racket. Eight employees of RBL Bank have been suspended in this matter. (Read full report) Cyber fraud opened 164

bank accounts. These employees had opened 164 bank accounts in violation of the rules to help the accused. Not only this, even when the cyber fraud money was frozen, they immediately informed the accused and advised them to withdraw the remaining money, the police investigation has also revealed. The role of RBL Bank employees in this entire racket of fraud by setting up fake shops and shops was not limited to just being an assistant, but they were working as direct partners with the criminals. The investigation of Udhna police has revealed that people including accused Kirat Jadwani were setting up fake shops and shops. Based on this fake setup, RBL Bank employees were opening current bank accounts by ignoring the rules. This bank account was used to transfer the money obtained through cyber fraud. 'The accused used to transfer large amounts': DCP Bhagirath Gadhvi

Giving more information about this, DCP Bhagirath Gadhvi said, "We have exposed the role played by 8 bank employees in this case. These employees had opened 164 bank accounts on the basis of false documents. The most serious thing is that when a complaint of cyber fraud was registered on the NCCRP portal and the bank account was frozen, these employees used to immediately inform the accused about it. Not only this, they also used to advise the accused to immediately withdraw the remaining amount except the frozen amount. Based on this advice, the accused used to transfer large amounts."

'Lookout notice issued against the sister of the main accused Kirat Jadwani' DCP Gadhvi added that the

police have also obtained the statements of all these bank employees and all the details of their bank accounts and legal action is underway. Vrinda Jadwani is also under suspicion. The police have also issued a lookout notice against Vrinda Jadwani, the sister of the main accused in this case, Kirat Jadwani.

'Vrinda's involvement suspected in this entire case' DCP Bhagirath Gadhvi said, "Vrinda's involvement is suspected in this entire case. We have also found some of her chats with bank employees. We are investigating whether this mobile number was used by Vrinda or by someone else. If solid evidence is found, action will be taken against her as well. A lookout notice has been issued based on her passport number."

Crores of rupees seized, investigation widens Police have so far seized a total of 164 bank accounts, out of which Rs 1.29 crore has been recovered. Apart from this, Rs 1.40 crore in the bank account of the main accused Kirat Jadwani has also been seized. Thus, the police have seized a total of Rs 2.5 crore. Kirat was also using three USB wallets, an investigation has been started regarding their money trail. It is suspected that transactions worth crores of rupees were made through these wallets.International racket, operated from Dubai Surat Police has busted an international cyber fraud racket, which has been revealed to be operated from Dubai, Cuba, Thailand and Malaysia. These cyber mafias were defrauding citizens using popular methods like part-time jobs, work from home, online trading, crypto and USDT trading, sextortion and digital arrest. In this racket, thousands of crores of rupees have been sent abroad through 165 accounts by Kirat Jadwani, Mehul Italia and Divyesh Chakrarani.
