

Committed suicide with the weapon ordered to rob a party in Dubai

6 crimes against Kalpesh Tudia, deceased in Bopal firing case, living a hi-fi lifestyle

Ahmedabad

The investigation into the suicide case of Bopal stockbroker Kalpesh Tudia revealed that the deceased had been charged with 6 serious crimes, including impersonating a fake police officer and extorting money. The investigation also revealed that he had also been charged with illegal possession of weapons, fraud, assault, theft, and possession of alcohol. The police have arrested Sahir Khan Malek and Rashid Khan Malek of Surendranagar, who had come to meet the deceased, and have started questioning them. They have also started taking statements from close friends, people involved in dabba trading, and others. The investigation has revealed that Kalpesh had ordered weapons to rob a party in Dubai, which is why he committed suicide.

There was a gunshot wound on the head: DSP

DSP Om Prakash Jat informed that an incident took place on August 5. Around 10 am, a call came from Saraswati Hospital that a man had been brought here in a bloody condition and was undergoing treatment. When we reached there immediately, the hospital declared him dead. He had a gunshot wound on the head. Later, on questioning his wife and daughter, it was found that 2 people had come to meet him.

'My father was carrying something hidden in a T-shirt'

The daughter said during interrogation that my father told me that I was going with these two people. I told him that my father was carrying something hidden in a T-shirt.



My father said that I was going with him after changing my clothes. After a while, there was a loud gunshot. When the daughter reached the spot after hearing the sound, she saw her father in a bloody state. Later, she called her mother.

'2 men arrested'

Later, the two men who were there also left. Our investigation revealed that they had taken the weapon with them. Later, we identified the vehicle by analyzing the CCTV. Based on the phone details, we arrested both of them.

'Kalpesh has 6 crimes registered'

Both the accused said that they knew Kalpesh for the last 6-7 years. Kalpesh also has 6 crimes registered against him, including cases of robbery and cheating. Sahir, who was carrying a weapon, also has crimes registered against him in many places including Surendranagar and Gandhidham.

'Weapons were ordered to extort money from a party in Dubai'

According to Sahir, Kalpesh had told him a day or two ago that a party was coming from Dubai and he

would extort money from them and return the weapons to them in a day or two. That's why he had brought the weapons.

'A suicide note was found from the deceased'

A suicide note has also been found from the pocket of the deceased Kalpesh. A forensic PM has also been done. Although all the experts are of the opinion of suicide, we are investigating from different angles. The help of a handwriting expert is being taken for the suicide note.

'The financial condition of the deceased was not good'

The suicide note mentions taking Rs 25 lakh from a person. His interrogation is also ongoing. Further investigation has revealed that his financial condition was not good at the moment. His lifestyle was high-fi and his current condition did not match it.

Due to financial hardship, many people were asking him for money and due to this, the investigation so far has revealed that he committed suicide.

Triple accident between container-tanker and car

Morbi

A horrific triple accident has taken place on the Maliya-Surajbari bridge in Morbi. A container overturned and collided with an Artiga car coming from behind. The car caught fire in this accident, resulting in the tragic deaths of two students and the driver and cleaner of the truck.

How did the accident happen?

A serious triple accident took place on the Morbi-Kutch highway near the Surajbari bridge near Haripar village in Maliya Miyana taluka at around 11 pm last night. First, a container overturned. After that, the tanker coming behind it collided with the container. In this accident, the Ertiga car coming from behind also collided with the tanker.

Tragic death of two students and the truck driver and cleaner

The vehicles caught fire after the accident. A total of four people, including two children and the tanker driver and cleaner, who were travelling in the Ertiga car, were burnt in the fire. Seven other people travelling in the Ertiga car suffered minor and major injuries. The injured were shifted to a private hospital in Samakhiyari for treatment.

Names of the deceased

Rudra Gopalbhai Gujaria - Age 15 years, resident of Mithi Rohar, Gandhidham, Kutch.

Jaimeen Jagdishbhai Babaria - Age 17 years, resident of Mithi Rohar, Gandhidham, Kutch.

Shivram Mangalaram Nai - Res. Bikaner, Rajasthan.

One deceased is yet to be identified.

The deceased students were studying in Ahir Boarding School in Junagadh.

The deceased have been identified as Rudra Gopalbhai Gujaria (aged 15) and Jaimeen Jagdishbhai Babaria

(aged 17), both residents of Mithi Rohar, Gandhidham, and Shivram Mangalam Nai, Bikaner, Rajasthan. Both these students were studying in Ahir Boarding School in Junagadh and were going to their hometown Gandhidham for the seventh and eighth festivals.

The bodies were shifted to Rajkot for postmortem.

Maliya Taluka Police and Morbi District SP rushed to the spot immediately after being informed about the incident and work was done to shift the vehicles involved in the accident to the road side and the Kutch-Morbi highway has been cleared. Five students injured in the accident have been shifted to Samakhiyali hospital for immediate treatment.

Police are investigating to identify the truck driver and the cleaner. All the bodies have been shifted to Rajkot for postmortem. The incident has sent a wave of mourning across the area.

The trailer was going from Morbi to Dehradun.

The trailer involved in this triple accident belonged to Haryana Chandigarh Transport Company. Jagdish Chaudhary, a representative of Haryana Chandigarh Transport Company, reached the spot and informed that the driver Shivkumar and cleaner Kishan had left for Dehradun after loading tiles from a ceramic factory in Morbi.

Five-kilometer-long traffic jam, accident-affected vehicles shifted A

five-kilometer-long traffic jam was created on the highway heading towards Kutch after an accident near Maliya-Surajbari bridge. A team of police and highway authority immediately reached the spot and started the work of shifting the accident-affected vehicles to one side of the road.

Divya Bhaskar's team visited the markets of major cities of Gujarat to find out the trend of Babubu. In which very surprising and interesting information came to light.

Labubhu gold pendant craze in Ahmedabad

Anand Prajapati, manager of a jewellery shop in Ahmedabad, said that for the last one and a half to two months, we have been making jewellery with the Labubhu theme. So far, we have sold 4-5 pieces and more than 100 inquiries have been received. This has been launched as a best gift option especially for Raksha Bandhan. The weight of this pendant is about 11 to 11.50 grams and its estimated price is 1 lakh 5 thousand to 1 lakh 10 thousand rupees.



He further said, "This trend was earlier in cartoons and purses and now it is also very popular in gold jewellery. People are liking it a lot because it is a new character. It is currently available in pink, baby pink and green colours and customers are also demanding the colour of their choice."

Like Mumbai-Delhi, demand will increase in Gujarat too.

Bhargava Parmar, owner of Satyam Art Jewellery in Surat, said that Labubu doll jewellery has become very popular, so we have converted it into jewellery. This is made in skill based, copper based, brass based. It is imitation art and artificial jewellery. Which people use in daily wear. People can wear it for a long time.

Bhargava Parmar further said, currently there is a lot of demand for this Labubu jewellery. There is a lot of demand in the outer cities, i.e. metro cities like Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Hyderabad, although currently there is no such demand in cities like Surat, Ahmedabad, Vadodara of Gujarat, but in the future there will be a demand for Labubu jewellery. Labubu has become popular all over the world.

Shivangi Agarwal from Surat has made India's first 6-foot tall Labubu doll out of 1500 rose flowers. With the

desire to do something different, she has made the largest viral doll. Shivangi Agarwal said that it took four days to make this doll with the help of 6 people. More than 1500 roses were used in the 6-foot doll. Shivangi Agarwal has been making various types of bouquets and flower baskets from flowers for the last 4 years.

People of all ages are buying it,

said Shailesh Shukla, owner of Sam's Toy Shop in Ahmedabad, that Labubu doll is currently in trend, the reason for this is that all the film stars, celebrities and everyone is promoting it, buying it themselves and also posting it on social media. Due to this, its demand is high at present. People of all ages are currently buying Labubu, but the trend is more among older people and special girls and ladies.

More than 10 thousand pieces sold in 3 months

He further said that there is negativity spread about this doll among the people, it is also called monster doll. In India, when anything comes into trend, negative words also come. Everyone says that, but it is not like that. This is a kind of toy. We have been selling for the last 3 months and we have sold more than 10 thousand pieces.

Hasan Johar, a trader at Johar Card and Gift Shop in Rajkot, told Divya Bhaskar that Labubu child belt is currently available in the market, which has become very popular among children, along with different types of pillows available, which children like to sleep with at night.

You can tell which bet will win without looking at the cards

A dangerous case of cheating in gambling in Rajkot before the seventh and eighth rounds, a cat with chemicals, a fly Bluetooth, and eye lenses seized

A warning incident has also come to light for gambling enthusiasts. Now it has come to light that fraud is being done with the help of technology in Teenpatti gambling as well. Rajkot Crime Branch raided the house of a person named Vipul Patel living in Vavdi area and seized 75 eye lenses, 4260 Ganjifani cat, four Bluetooth flies and four mobile phones, totaling Rs 2.70 lakh.

By scanning the cards with the help of a card reader and a mobile phone, information is obtained using Bluetooth about how many players will win. Not only this, but with the help of a lens, the cards can also be seen through, so that it can be known which card the other person has in the game. Thus, this can be said to be a warning for gamblers, because by cheating like this, the gambler keeps winning money continuously and the proverb that the losing gambler plays twice as much becomes true.

How does cheating happen?

First, gambling is started with a chemically treated deck of cards. At this time, a remote control is also kept with it, with the help of which the number of people who sit down to gamble is pressed in this remote. After this, the cards are dealt, in which at this time the mobile phone is kept near the cards, because this mobile has a sensor, with the help of which the cards are scanned. As soon as the cards are scanned, how many numbers of the people who are sitting down to play will be the winner is scanned and it is known through the screen of the mobile phone and the earpieces attached to the



Bluetooth.

The police, while interrogating a person named Vipul Patel, who was caught with all the items, found that the cards of all the cards seized were chemically contaminated. By wearing the soft

contact lens worn in the eyes, the cards of the deck can be seen through. Also, by scanning all the cards of the deck with the mobile phone sensor in the kit of the sensor-equipped Android mobile phone, which of the bets placed while gambling is the biggest and the number of bets that can be won is displayed on the mobile screen and Bluetooth speaker.

4260 pieces of card, 75 soft contact lenses, 4-4 mobile phones-Bluetooth were found.

The Rajkot city Crime Branch team was on patrol. During this, based on specific

information received by Chetansinh Raghuvver Singh Gohil, Umeshbhai Mavjibhai Chavda and Deepakbhai Manubhai Dangar, a raid was conducted at Akar Heights, I Wing Flat No. 502, Punitnagar Vavdi, next to Radhe Shyam Gaushala, on the 150 feet ring road of Rajkot city.

The police found chemical-laced playing cards, soft contact lenses, sensor-equipped Android mobile phones and Bluetooth devices that could be used for gambling. The accused had brought all these items for sale, so the police have registered a complaint against a person named Vipul Patel and seized 4260 playing cards, 75 soft contact lenses, four mobile phones and four Bluetooth devices, seized a total of Rs 2.70 lakh worth of goods and sent them to the FSL.

Std. 10 student jumps to death from sixth floor

Surat

A 16-year-old student named Ashvita Damor, studying in class 10, has ended her life by jumping from the sixth floor after going to a construction site about 4 kilometers away from her home. The student has committed suicide by going to Pandesara from her home in Bhestan. When Ashvita reached the construction site, the security guard there shouted at her, but before he could understand anything or take any action, she went straight to the sixth floor and jumped. After that, the guard immediately informed the police. On the evening of August 7, 2025, Ashvita told her family that she had come from tuition and was now going to her sister's house. But she did not return till 8 pm and the family became worried when her mobile phone was switched off. After waiting till 11 pm, the family finally filed a missing complaint at the Bhestan police station.

Police reached the construction site based on the location. On receiving this complaint, Bhestan police took immediate action. The police started searching for Ashvita based on the location of her mobile phone. When the location was found in Pandesara area, the police turned towards it. During the investigation, it was found that Ashvita had come from Bhestan to Tirupati Circle in Pandesara in a rickshaw. From here, she walked alone and reached the Sapolok construction site, which is about five minutes away from Tirupati Circle. A team of Pandesara police and Bhestan police reached the spot. The police found that Ashvita's body was lying on the construction site. The police immediately informed the family and the father Hiteshbhai also reached the spot. Seeing his daughter in this condition, the entire family was shocked. The father's

heartbreaking cry made the atmosphere sad.

Suspicion of committing suicide or throwing herself out of fear of someone: A prominent tribal community leader Hiteshbhai said about the incident that Ashvita's

family was told that she had come from tuition and was now going to a friend's house, but we were worried when she did not return. After the police investigation, we came to know that she was at the construction site of a tower

called Omkar Residential here in Pandesara. Why the rickshaw went to Tirupati Circle is also a matter of investigation. We fear that she may have committed suicide due to some fear or she may have been thrown away.

Investigation of the student's phone In this case, Inspector H.M. Gadhvi of Pandesara police station said that the student came from Bhestan to Tirupati Circle in Pandesara in an auto and from there walked to the construction site.
