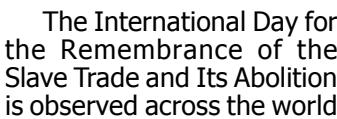


The Road to Abolition - A Journey of Courage and Resilience

It is a commonly practiced tradition (despite being outlawed) that the bride's family pays a large sum of money to the groom's family at the wedding. Plus, women are generally not seen as bread-winners and are allowed to inherit wealth like men in some states. Sex-selection is now spreading to rural areas as the technology gets cheaper and enforcement of the law remains ineffectual. The imbalance in sex ratio may increase violence, including rape, against women. With many men remaining unmarried, prostitution will increase substantially. Media exposes of doctors providing sex-selection services and offering to abort girls are commonplace.



on 23 August. It is said that for over 400 years, more than 15 million men, women and children were the victims of the tragic transatlantic slave trade, one of the darkest chapters in human history. The International Day aims to raise awareness about the dangers of racism and prejudice today.

The abolition of slavery has been seen throughout history as a way to have all people be treated equal. Our villages have a number of people who are oppressed and exploited like the Dalits, landless labourers, poor farmers, etc. But the condition of the bonded labourers was the worst. They were made to live as slaves or serfs throughout their lives.

The records of slave trade

that flourished around the 15th century in the region show that the practice was carried out on the basis of proper "sale agreements" and that it was not uncommon for lower caste parents to pledge their children to be bonded labour several years. One of the main reasons for the practice of slave trade was that so-called people of white race had the belief of superiority over the black people to whom they referred as Negroes and did not consider them human. Though slavery was abolished in India by the Indian Slavery Act of 1843, it was prevalent till 1910. "In south India, there are several references to the prevalence of slaves bought to work in the lands or temples.

According to the Global Slavery Index , on an average, 51 out of every 100 people in India are vulnerable to modern slavery - bonded labour, forced begging, forced marriage, domestic services and commercial sex work . Forced- and child-marriage are high in India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Nepal and Indonesia. A sex-ratio imbalance, resulting in absence of brides in India, has fuelled the trafficking of women and forced marriage. The supreme court has ruled in various decisions that bonded labour can be regarded as a form of forced labour and hence is unconstitutional under Article 23. This is the fundamental rights guaranteed by our Indian constitution and to give

effect to article 23. Parliament has enacted the Bonded Labor System Act, 1976. The Act makes the system of bonded labour a punishable offence. Late Smt. Indira Gandhi, the former Prime Minister of India, declared that the system of bonded labour was a barbarous system. Therefore, it must go. Accordingly, the Government of India issued the "Bonded Labour Abolition Ordinance" on 24th October, 1975. This Ordinance has since become an Act. Under the Act, the evil institution of slavery which had continued all these years was abolished. The practice of bonded labour persists in India, mainly because of debt, and the entire family is exposed

to the risks of physical violence. People are forced to work under unhealthy conditions, and physical violence is meted out, if they refuse to work. The bonded labour system is one of the main characteristics of the feudal hierarchical society. The system was designed to enable a few socially and economically powerful sections of society to exploit the weaker sections of the society.

Let us remember that we as a society must have to change our attitude towards persons of weaker sections and try to restore the value of human dignity which is a part of the right to life. (B-15 Jyoti-Kalash Society, Jodhpur Tekra, Satellite, Ahmedabad - 380 015)

Ahmedabad, Every fourth bus plying on Gujarat's roads has exceeded its statutory mileage, meaning that lakhs of passengers are travelling in buses every day at the risk of their lives. GSRTC had passed a resolution in December 2007, according to which if an ST bus has completed 8 lakh kilometres, it will be considered overage, meaning that the ST itself considers the bus to be in a bad condition, but keeps it running.

Gujarat ST may have been claiming for years that 'Safe ride, ST is ours', but it would not be wrong to say that this slogan is limited to being pasted on the bus stand and the windows of ST buses. The worst condition is that of express buses plying on long routes. The condition of red-boarded buses that charge higher fares and deliver faster is like a red alert. GSRTC manages the entire state of Gujarat by dividing it into 16 districts. As per the official figures as on August 1, 2025, the ST Corporation has a total of 7,678 buses of sleeper, semi, super express and mini categories. Out of these, 2,102 buses are average, meaning they have covered 8 lakh kilometres. The situation is such that the drivers, who are the backbone of Gujarat ST, are now fed up. A few days ago, a driver at the Bantwadia bus depot in Junagadh, after being allotted a condom bus, tried to commit suicide by dousing himself in diesel. He had said, 'I would rather die than risk the lives of innocent

passengers by driving a bad vehicle.' After this incident, Divya Bhaskar obtained data of more than seven and a half thousand buses of Gujarat Transport Corporation, in which how old is which bus? And how many kilometers has it run? What is the type of bus? He analyzed it. This data, which is available with the names of various divisions and depots, is proof that lakhs of passengers are travelling in government buses in Gujarat every day at the risk of their lives and it seems that people sitting in high positions are waiting for a big accident. Not only this, the division that uses less diesel gets an award. There have also been allegations that officials are pressuring drivers to drive slower buses in the desire to win this award. As the festival approaches, you must have seen a huge crowd of passengers at the bus stands of the big cities of Gujarat - Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Rajkot and Surat. Perhaps you yourself will be part of this crowd.

There are 1,906 buses in the division of these four cities, the pride of Gujarat. You will be shocked to know that 426 of these buses are overage. Moreover, the maximum number of 303 buses out of them are of the super express category. So, there is every possibility that if you have traveled long distances in ST, you will have sat in a bus whose kilometers have been completed according to the ST's own rules. Out of the 16 divisions of Gujarat ST,

Mehsana and Nadiad have the highest number of buses. Mehsana has 802 and Nadiad has 723. Of these, 283 buses in Mehsana and 223 in Nadiad are said to be overage on government documents, meaning that one in every four buses is in bad condition, although these buses are kept running with passengers in the name of being in good condition.

In this list, one bus from Mehsana belongs to the sleeper category, which is run on very long routes.

In this list, the situation in Bhuj and Surat is slightly better than other divisions. 57 out of 376 buses coming to Bhuj and 75 out of 455 buses allocated to Surat are broken down, although one of the reasons behind this figure is that the total number of buses in both places is less, but most of these buses, which have covered 8 lakh kilometers, are Super Express. Even the drivers and conductors are now scared of the noisy ST. If they raise their voices, they fear losing their jobs, so some employees say on

condition of anonymity, as per the rules, the bus has to be sent to the workshop within a certain time frame. Where the fitness of the bus is checked. In Gujarat ST buses, things like changing the engine oil, power steering oil, coolant level check, fan belt check, service brake, gear box oil, checking nuts and bolts, checking the air pressure of the tires, light indicator, switch, battery, earthing, etc. have to be checked, but many works are not done on time. The Election Commission is asking for an affidavit under pressure from the BJP government. Asking for an affidavit is a way to hide the theft. This is not a fight for winning the election. But it is a fight for democracy. It is our responsibility as citizens. We request the aware citizens that this is not only about Congress but also about Gujarat and Indians. When the record-breaking victory in Gujarat was announced, a certain thought came to mind, so we investigated the record-breaking assembly itself.
