India, China can bring stability to economic order: PM' Modi's message from Japan

progress has been made in our bilateral ties," he told Japanese media.

"Stable, predictable, and amicable bilateral relations between India and China, the two largest nations on Earth, can have a positive impact on regional and global peace and prosperity," he said, echoing remarks after meeting Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi in Delhi this month.

"This is also crucial for a multi-polar Asia and world." The summit - the 25th time heads of member-states will meet - comes as India navigates global economic and geopolitical turbulence arising from Russia's war on Ukraine, Israel's war on Gaza, and the United States' 50 per cent tariff on Indian goods exported to that country. The US' move, in particular, has led to a thaw in decades-long India-China military tension, as the two Asian giants recalibrate ties to offset potential economic losses arising from the taxes.

Evidence of that thaw emerged in March as the US began taxing Chinese goods, and Wang Yi urged Delhi and Beijing to "take the lead in opposing hegemonism and power politics".

Mr Wang said then that "making the dragon and elephant dance is the only right choice". That metaphor was later picked up China's Xi Jinping too, a sign Beijing is serious about exploring more mutually beneficial ties with India. In fact, there are whispers Mr Xi personally reached out.

In Japan today, the PM acknowledged those sentiments, and said, "Given volatility in the world economy, it is important for India and China to work together to bring stability to the world economic order. India is ready to advance bilateral relations from a strategic and long-term perspective on the basis of mutual interest..."

These mutual interest areas will likely include the EV, or Electric Vehicle, industry, which is already heavily reliant on rare earth minerals that are a key part of the manufacturing.

Specific goods and sectors aside, the massive Indian and Chinese markets will boost the other's economy, particularly as each tries to diversify export markets to offset the Trump tariff impact.

Further evidence of that is the two countries agreeing to step up trade and resume direct flights, both measures seen as major diplomatic breakthroughs. The decision to disengage in Ladakh - where military tensions skyrocketed after the 2020 Galwan clashes - was another positive step.

Wang Yi's visit to Delhi earlier this month, his first in three years, added to what seems to be rapidly (given the India-China context) normalising relations between the two countries.

Mr Modi is widely expected to meet Mr Xi when in

China next week.

‘Don’t burden women’: Owaisi slams Bhagwat, Moitra attack Amit Shah

Targeting the ruling BJP, Owaisi also demanded the political retirement of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah. “We must retire them politically by ensuring the BJP doesn’t return to power. That is how we defeat them,” he said.

TMC MP Mahua Moitra’s blazing remarks on Shah Owaisi’s comments came as a reaction to the TMC MP Mahua Moitra’s remarks on Shah.

Moitra sparked a major row with her sharp attack on Union Home Minister Amit Shah, saying he should be held accountable for failing to curb the infiltration of illegal Bangladeshi migrants into India. She alleged that it was the failure of Shah’s Home Ministry to check infiltration and accused him of shifting the blame onto the TMC.

Reacting to Moitra’s comment, Owaisi condemned her remarks and stated that it is unjust to use ‘violence’ against the leader. Talking to ANI, he said, “I don’t know in what context the TMC MP made such a statement. We have and we will continue to take pride in differences with Mr Amit Shah. But can we use violence against Amit Shah? I don’t think so...I think she (TMC MP) is better to throw more light on that (her reported statement). But yes, we must oppose the BJP, Narendra Modi and Amit Shah. We must retire them politically. We must not give them the opportunity; they will decide when to leave politics. We must go to the Indian people, take more of them into confidence, so that the next time the BJP doesn’t win the election. That is how we retire them and defeat them.”

Infiltration is a major flashpoint in the run-up to the 2026 Assembly polls.

He stated, “Strong democracies are natural partners in shaping a better world. Today, we have laid the foundation of a new and golden chapter in our special strategic and global partnership. ‘Winning combination’

PM Modi further stated, “We believe that Japanese technology and Indian talent are a winning combination. Where we are working on high-speed rail, under next-generation mobility partnership we will also make rapid progress in sectors like ports, aviation and ship-building. For cooperation in Chandrayaan 5 Mission, we welcome the agreement between ISRO and JAXA. Our active cooperation will cross the boundaries of the earth and become a symbol of humanity’s progress in space.”

“At the centre of our vision are investment, innovation, economic security, environment, technology, health, mobility, people-to-people exchanges, and state-prefecture partnership. We have set a target of 10 trillion yen investment from Japan to India over the next 10 years,” he added.

PM Modi talked about the formation of a roadmap with respect to the bilateral relationship of the two countries for the next decade.

He further said, “We are also launching the Sustainable Fuels Initiative and Battery Supply Chain Partnership. We are launching the Economic Security Cooperation Initiative. Under this, we will move forward with a comprehensive approach in critical and strategic sectors.”

Cooperation in the high technology sector is a priority for both the countries, he stated. In this context, the Digital Partnership 2.0 and AI cooperation initiative is being undertaken, he further said.

Earlier today, PM Modi also met with former Japanese prime ministers Yoshihide Suga and Fumio Kishida during his visit to Tokyo. The meetings focused on deepeni India-Japan cooperation across various sectors.
