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Attempt to snatch PI's revolver, two rounds fired, accused shot

Ahmedabad, The Crime Branch team was taking the criminal Sangram Singh Sikarwar, who had kidnapped a real estate agent in Ramol, Ahmedabad and absconded with a ransom of more than Rs 52 lakh, for investigation late at night. Meanwhile, while reaching the riverfront, the accused snatched the PI's revolver and tried to escape. During the scuffle, two rounds were fired, in which one bullet hit the accused in the leg. Two policemen were also injured in this incident and are undergoing treatment in the civil hospital. The accused is currently undergoing treatment and his condition is stable.
