left main canal works must be completed by January 2026 to facilitate water supply up to Anakapalli. Simultaneously, land acquisition and rehabilitation activities should be completed without delay. The Chief Minister also instructed officials to focus on developing the Polavaram project site as a major tourism destination. Repairs to several reservoirs: Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy Civil Affairs and Housing Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy said that the cabinet has approved the work of the Amidyala Lift Scheme in the Handri-Neeva project. We are developing a world-class aerospace and defense ecosystem there.” Priyank Kharge hit back with biting sarcasm, saying: “It is natural for weak systems to attempt to strengthen themselves. There’s nothing wrong with that. But when such efforts reach a point of desperation, they only weaken further.” DKS Advertisement Kharge went on to list Bengaluru’s achievements and growth trajectory, asserting that the city remains one of the strongest global hubs. “Bengaluru is projected to witness 8.5% GDP growth until 2035, making it one of the fastest-growing cities in the world. Property values are expected to rise by 5% in 2025,” he noted. He further highlighted that Bengaluru consistently ranks high in global indices of urbanization, innovation, and economic growth. “By 2025, the city’s population is projected to reach 14.4 million, growing annually at 2.76%. It is among India’s top migration hubs,” Kharge stated. In a parting shot, he quipped with a pointed metaphor, asking rhetorically: “What do you call a living being that survives only by sucking nutrients from another?” a jibe clearly aimed at Lokesh.

Officials informed the CM that 33 TMC of rainfall has been recorded in the Gotta Barrage catchment and 11 TMC in the Thotapalli area. The Srikakulam Collector informed that 1.89 lakh cusecs of flood is coming to Gotta Barrage and 44 thousand cusecs to Thotapalli. He explained that 1.05 lakh cusecs of water is coming to Vamsadhara due to heavy rains in many parts of Odisha. Meanwhile, officials told Chandrababu during the review that four people have died due to heavy rains and accidents. It was revealed that one person died in Kancharapalem, Visakhapatnam city, two in Mandasa, Srikakulam district, and one in Kurupam, Parvathipuram, Manyam district. The CM ordered the officials to provide a compensation of Rs. 4 lakh each to the affected families. He said that there is currently no rain in the districts of Uttarandhra... There is flooding in the rivers due to the currents coming from above. Trees have fallen in some places due to heavy rains.. They said that 90 percent of the fallen trees have already been removed. EPDCL officials revealed that power supply has been restored to about 90 percent of the districts of North Andhra. They have ordered that power

should be restored in all areas by this evening. Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has instructed the officials to ensure that there is no delay in restoring power supply.
