

Ranya Rao Arrest: "Law Will Do Its Job"

IPS Officer On Actor Daughter's Arrest For Smuggling



Bengaluru, March, 5 (UNI): The senior police officer whose daughter - Ranya Rao - was arrested at Bengaluru airport Monday night, after officials found 14.8kg of gold in her possession, has been left "shocked and devastated" by the news, and has also sought to distance himself from the entire affair. "The law will do its job. There is no black mark on my career," he told. Ramachandra Rao, Director-General of Police (Karnataka State Police Housing Corporation), also said, "Like any other father, I was shocked and devastated when it

after she arrived from Dubai on an Emirates flight. Source said the arresting officers found her trying to smuggle gold into the country by wearing a significant amount and concealing the rest in her clothing. There are also reports saying two aides carried gold bars in briefcases.

Preliminary inquiries suggest she used her connections to skip security checks; she reportedly announced herself as the daughter of a Karnataka DGP and contacted local cops for an escort. However, authorities had been tracking Ms Rao for some time; their suspicions were aroused after she made four trips to Dubai in 15 days. And, after this last trip, they sprang their trap. They had almost cleared customs and were about to leave the airport when the DRI team stopped her and started a search. The nearly 15kg of gold that was seized has been valued at a staggering

Rs 12.56 crore, which is one of the largest from Bengaluru airport in recent years. And that wasn't all. Officials then searched Ms Rao's home, which she shared with her husband, on Bengaluru's Lavelle Road and found Rs 2.06 crore in gold jewellery and cash worth Rs 2.67 crore. "The passenger has been placed under arrest under relevant provisions of the Customs Act, and remanded to judicial custody. The total in the case stands at Rs. 17.29 crore, marking a significant blow to organised gold smuggling networks," a DRI statement said. The investigation is now focused on uncovering possible links to cops, or others, who may have helped her. It will also establish if she was acting alone or was part of a larger network. Ms Rao - an actor known for her role opposite Kannada superstar Sudeep in 'Maanikyaa', which was released in 2014 - is now being questioned at the DRI's office in the city.

"We are the only opposition"

Jagan Reddy after andhra assembly setback

A massive political row has erupted in Andhra Pradesh after Speaker Ayyanna Patrudu rejected YSR Congress Party chief YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's request for the Leader of the Opposition tag. Terming it an "unreasonable desire", the Speaker said a party must have a minimum of 18 members to qualify for the Leader of the Opposition post, but YSR Congress has 11. Mr Reddy, who lost the Chief Minister post after his party was routed in the Assembly polls held alongside the Lok Sabha election last year, has trashed the Speaker's rationale behind denying him the post and questioned how people's voices would be raised in the House if the only party in the Opposition is not given sufficient time. He also cited a Delhi example and said the AAP had given the BJP Opposi-



tion party status when the latter had just 3 members in the Assembly.

In his ruling on Mr Reddy's request, the Speaker said, "The eligibility for the position of Leader of Opposition is determined solely in accordance with constitutional provisions, legal mandates, and established precedents." Citing various rules to bolster his ruling, he said, "Accordingly, in the 175-member Legislative Assembly of Andhra Pradesh, unless the largest party in opposition attains a minimum strength of 18 Members, it would be improper to consider the leader of such a party for recognition as the Leader of the Opposition purely on discretion." The Speaker noted that Mr Reddy had approached the High Court, seeking a direction to the Speaker to designate him as the 'Leader of the Opposition'. "The fact is that his writ petition, as of today, is not even admitted by Hon'ble High Court. I am not surprised by the repeated malicious and vit-

riolic campaign being carried out by Sri Jagan Mohan Reddy," he said, criticising the YSR Congress chief.

The Speaker said Mr Reddy's allegations attributing motives to the Chair amount to breach of privilege and contempt of the House. "I have decided to treat his diatribe with the contempt it deserves. I am not sure if the House would tolerate any further, recurrence of such deplorable conduct."

Hitting back at the Speaker's decision, Mr Reddy said YSR Congress is the only party that sits in the Opposition in Andhra Assembly. "BJP, Jana Sena and TDP are together and they are ruling parties. And be it any number, the fact remains that we are 40 per cent vote share. We are the only party in the Opposition, if we are not given the recognition, then who is going to be the Opposition party? Once the party is recognised as the Opposition party, its leader is the Leader of the Opposition. The advantage is that

Speaker must give (him/her) the mic and time on par with the Leader of the House." "Only when the Opposition speaks up, it is given sufficient time, issues come up and the government takes corrective measures. If you are not going to do that, then you have nobody to speak as the Opposition party, you don't want them to voice out people's concerns, only the ruling party will speak, then when will the people's issues be placed in the House," he asked. Citing the example of the Delhi Assembly after the 2015 polls, when AAP won 67 out of 70 seats, he said, "AAP had given the BJP Opposition party status when it had three MLAs in Delhi and there was a Leader of the Opposition." Addressing the House on the issue, minister and TDP general secretary Nara Lokesh said Parliament rules clearly define the criteria for the Opposition Party tag. "People of Andhra Pradesh decided that YSRCP should not get Opposition party status," he said.

Day after spitting case, UP assembly bans gutkha; announces Rs 1,000 fine for violators



Lucknow, March, 5 (UNI): Uttar Pradesh Assembly Speaker Satish Mahana on Wednesday announced a ban on gutkha and pan masala within the

Assembly premises. The announcement came a day after Mahana expressed his displeasure over an incident where a member was caught on camera spitting pan masala inside the Assembly premises during the House proceedings on Tuesday morning. The speaker had reportedly asked staff members to clean the mess. Mahana, however, had not named the MLA but said he knew who it was. Expressing strong disapproval, the speaker had reminded all members of their responsibility towards cleanliness as lawmakers elected by the public. After the Question Hour on Wednesday, Mahana announced, "With immediate effect, the use of pan masala and gutkha is banned inside the Assembly premises." "Anyone, including employees, officials or any other individuals, found consuming gutkha or pan masala within the Assembly premises will be fined Rs 1,000. Necessary action will be taken in accordance with the rules," he added. Some members present in the Assembly suggested that the fine amount should be increased due to inflation. Responding in a light-hearted manner, Mahana quipped, "Note down the names of those honourable members demanding a higher fine. If they are caught spitting, we will charge them extra." His remarks sparked laughter among the Assembly members.

"Mortgaged gold, hard work paid off": Boatman who earned Crores in Kumbh

Prayagraj, March, 5 (UNI): Inspired by the earnings of boat operators during the 2019 Ardh Kumbh, a boatman's family in Uttar Pradesh's Prayagraj took a bold entrepreneurial step during the recently concluded Mahakumbh Mela 2025, generating a staggering profit of Rs 30 crore. Pintu Mahara, head of a boatman family, built 70 boats to cater to devotees and pilgrims during the 45-day grand religious gathering. Recalling his experience, Pintu, on Wednesday, spoke about how he took out a bank loan and even mortgaged personal jewelry to fund the project. Despite the financial risks, he was confident that the Mahakumbh would attract millions of devotees, and

his foresight paid off. Pintu credited his success to Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and Prime Minister Narendra Modi, acknowledging their efforts in supporting local businesses during the Mahakumbh. Over 300 people worked under Pintu's leadership, helping devotees with boat rides, bathing arrangements, and other services. His team also provided free dedicated services to enhance the experience for pilgrims. Pintu expressed his gratitude and hopes to participate in the next Mahakumbh 12 years later, once again under the patronage of the current government. He also dismissed the opposition's claims of exploitation, emphasising

the positive impact of government policies on local workers and traders. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday shared the success story of the boatman's family, highlighting their extraordinary earnings during the 45-day-long Mahakumbh from January 13 to February 26. "A boatman's family, who owned several boats, earned a total of Rs 30 crore in just 45 days during the Mahakumbh. This means each boat earned Rs 23 lakh over the 45 days, translating to about Rs 50,000-52,000 per day," CM Yogi said while addressing the UP State Legislative Assembly. He also refuted allegations by the Samajwadi Party that boatmen were exploited during the event.

Speaking about his journey, Pintu recalled the hardships his family faced, especially after his father's demise. "Life was tough. We had to borrow money and mortgage gold to build the boats. Six months of hard work paid off, as our boats became an integral part of the Mahakumbh experience, ferrying thousands of devotees," he said. Reflecting on the blessings he received, Pintu added, "After Mauni Amavasya, I felt the blessings of Goddess Lakshmi. Under the leadership of PM Modi and CM Yogi, the Mahakumbh became a grand success, making Prayagraj famous worldwide. Our business flourished, and we earned not just money, but the blessings of the people."

"Suspended from house despite withdrawing my remark on Aurangzeb": Abu Azmi

Mumbai, March, 5 (UNI): SPMLA Abu Asim Azmi, who was suspended from the Maharashtra assembly on Wednesday over his comment praising Mughal emperor Aurangzeb, said the action against him was taken despite him retracting his remark. In a video statement released by his office, Azmi asserted he had not said anything wrong, but retracted the remark, which he made outside the assembly, to ensure the House functions. "Still I was suspended," he said. Earlier in the day, the state assembly passed a motion unanimously by a voice vote to suspend Azmi from the House till the end of the budget session. Members of the treasury benches said Azmi's

remark eulogising Aurangzeb was an insult of Maratha king Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and his son Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj. The budget session of the state legislature will end on March 26. Azmi, president of the Samajwadi Party's state unit, had said that during Aurangzeb's reign, India's border reached Afghanistan and Burma (Myanmar). "Our GDP accounted for 24 per cent (of the world GDP) and India was called a golden sparrow (during his regime)," claimed the MLA from Mankhurd Shivaji Nagar constituency in Mumbai. Asked about the fight between Aurangzeb and Maratha king Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj, Azmi had termed it a political battle. His comments rocked both

houses of the state legislature on Tuesday, with members of the ruling side demanding his suspension and that he be booked for treason. After the outrage over his comments, Azmi in a post on X on Tuesday said his statements were twisted. "Whatever I have said about Aurangzeb is something that has been stated by historians and writers. I have not made any derogatory remarks against Shivaji Maharaj, Sambhaji Maharaj or any national icons. Still, if anyone is hurt by my remarks, then I take back my statements and comments," he said. Deputy Chief Minister and Shiv Sena head Eknath Shinde on Tuesday led the attack on Azmi both in the legislative council and assembly. "Azmi is purposely insulting



Shivaji Maharaj and Sambhaji Maharaj. Sambhaji's bravery and Aurangzeb's cruelty will give goosebumps to people," Shinde had said. The Mughal emperor not only killed Hindus but also people from other religions, he had said. Shinde dubbed Azmi a "traitor" and said he had no right to sit in the House.
