

Cyclone Montha: Andhra govt prepares action plan for relief, essential supplies

AMARAVATI, OCT 26 /--/ The Andhra Pradesh government has prepared an action plan for relief and essential supplies in pre-cyclone preparedness for Cyclone Montha. State Civil Supplies Minister N Manohar said the action plan covers stock positioning of Public Distribution System (PDS) commodities, fuel inventory management, paddy procurement steps, food supply to relief shelters and post-cyclone relief distribution.

"The Andhra Pradesh government has prepared an action taken report detailing the pre-cyclone preparedness measures for Cyclone Montha, ensuring readiness before landfall," Manohar said in an official release late on Saturday. The supply of food grains to all fair price shops in coastal areas shall be completed by October 26 and sufficient stock is already placed at Mandal Level Stock Points, he said. According to officials, 40 per cent stock movement

has been completed in coastal districts, and Global Positioning System (GPS) exemption has been granted for second-stage food grain movement based on requests from district collectors. On fuel preparedness, Manohar said the state nodal officer and oil marketing companies to fully stock petrol, diesel and Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) outlets in vulnerable districts. District collectors were directed to coordinate with Oil Marketing

Companies (OMCs) to ensure diesel availability for power backup at telecom towers, control rooms, hospitals and cyclone shelters during disruptions. On paddy procurement, officials informed the minister that procurement is expected to start in full scale in the first week of November, but centres will be opened wherever farmers arrive with harvested paddy to provide immediate relief. Nearly 1,500 mills have been

tagged to Rythu Service Kendras (RSKs) in coastal districts, and millers have been asked to provide drying space and covers for wet paddy, and not to distress farmers over high moisture levels owing to

adverse conditions. Further, 50,000 tarpaulins with ropes, sandbags and plastic sheets have been kept ready at RSKs for crop protection on a need basis. District Collectors have been authorised to draw

essential commodities from MLSPs for food preparation in cyclone shelters and disaster camps, and expenditure can be adjusted under Treasury Rule (TR)-27. For post-cyclone relief distribution,

sufficient stock has been placed at Mandal Level Stock Points (MLSPs) for supply as per the scale set by the Disaster Management Department under the notified relief norms. (PTI)

Man dies, wife injured as mudslide flattens houses in Kerala’s Idukki

IDUKKI (KERALA), OCT 26 /--/ A 48-year-old man died and his wife was severely injured after a mudslide, near the National Highway widening work, levelled at least eight houses at Mannamkandam in Adimali here, police said on Sunday. The incident occurred on Saturday night. The deceased has been identified as Biju of Lakshamveedu Unnathi. According to police, there were around 22 houses in the housing colony, and due to the risk of a mudslide, residents had been shifted to relief camps on Saturday. Adimali Block Panchayat member Krishnamoorthi told PTI that mud was being removed from the hilly area as part of the widening of NH-85. "The residential colony was located on the slope of the hill beneath the highway. As there was a possibility of a mudslide, panchayat officials issued a notice and 22 families were shifted to Adimali on Saturday evening," he said. However, Biju and his wife Sandhya, returned home later in the night to prepare food.

"When they were inside their house, mud from the hill collapsed and fell over the houses around 10.30 pm. Biju and Sandhya were trapped inside. Around eight houses were flattened in the slide," he said. Local residents alerted the police and Fire and Rescue Services, who launched a rescue operation.

"The couple was trapped under the debris. After a five-hour-long operation, they were pulled out. However, Biju succumbed to his injuries. Sandhya, who was initially admitted to a hospital in Adimali, was

later shifted to a hospital in Aluva," Krishnamoorthi said, and added that Sandhya's condition is stable now. Residents alleged that unscientific road widening was responsible for the tragedy.

"The mud is being removed as part of the highway work without any safety precautions. They are clearing the hill slopes without considering the risk of landslides," Sulfi, a resident said. Anas, whose house was completely destroyed, said residents had noticed major cracks in the hillside and had alerted panchayat officials. "The officials inspected the spot on Saturday morning and issued a notice asking us to evacuate due to the risk of a

landslide. We were shifted to the Adimali government school camp. But the NH work continued," he said. He added that living in the area was now dangerous as more slides were possible.

"We have nowhere else to go. We don't know how long we'll have to stay in the camp. The government should take steps to rehabilitate us," he said. A relative of the deceased person said that Biju's son died last year, and his daughter is a nursing student in Kottayam. Adimali police have registered a case of unnatural death in connection with Biju's demise and initiated an investigation. The body will be handed over to relatives after the post-mortem, police said. Gujarat: Students shine in studies as school helps them improve handwriting

AHMEDABAD, OCT 26 /--/ Under an initiative running for 15 years, a government school in Gujarat's Mehsana district is helping students improve their handwriting to boost their self-esteem and academic performance. Shreemati K B Shah Anupam Primary School in Vitroda village is transforming students' connection with Gujarat through a handwriting initiative led by teacher Adityabhai Darji since 2010. Besides "remarkable" improvements in handwriting, the students' vocabulary and overall expression have become clearer. Moreover, the school consistently excels in calligraphy, essay writing, and poetry competitions, said Darji.

"Gandhiji said that bad handwriting is a sign of incomplete education. When a child has poor handwriting, they are stressed about whether their results will be good. But when they write in beautiful handwriting, their confidence increases and they start believing in themselves," he said. The students have started writing better, and their connection with the language has also deepened, said the teacher. "This initiative has instilled discipline, patience, and creativity in the students," said Darji. According to the teacher, students are now making fewer mistakes, and their academic progress is clearly visible. "The school also honours students who excel in handwriting, which has boosted the children's confidence," he added. Students also said that their handwriting has become better due to the initiative. "I used to make many mistakes because of my handwriting, such as leaving too much space between letters. Because of these small mistakes, my handwriting used to look bad. But when I started correcting them, it became much more beautiful," said Atri Darji, a student of the school. Manasvita, another student, said, "A chart provided by Darji sir helped us improve our handwriting. It included the structure of handwriting, vowels, consonants, and a paragraph." The teacher said the project has fostered love and pride for the Gujarati language among the students. "It has not only resulted in better grades in exams but has also strengthened their cultural connection," he added. (PTI)

Centre committed to increasing farmers’ income, says Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan

VELLORE (TAMIL NADU), OCT 26 /--/ The central government is committed to increasing agriculture production and enhancing farmers' income, Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said. He said that four low-production districts of Tamil Nadu viz. Ramanathapuram, Sivaganga, Tuticorin, and Virudhunagar have been included in the Pradhan Mantri Dhan Dhaanya Krishi Yojana. Under this, 36 schemes of 11 central ministries were being integrated to deliver comprehensive benefits to farmers.

"We will work to increase production in these districts and make farmers prosperous," he said at the Chaupal programme at the KrishiVigyan Kendra here on Saturday. He interacted with farmers and officials of the KrishiVigyan Kendra and explained about the Pradhan Mantri Dhan Dhaanya Yojana and the Pulses Mission.

"The farmers here are very hardworking and are doing excellent work for natural farming," he said lauding the ryots of Tamil Nadu. He assured that concrete steps will be taken to address pest and disease issues affecting coconut crops. Efforts would be taken to mitigate the impact of price decline due to glut in mango production, and also to establish value-addition and processing units. All eligible farmers in Tamil Nadu will be linked to the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana to ensure maximum outreach and benefit, he said. Later, speaking to reporters, the minister said the state should work with the Centre to implement the schemes properly so that farmers could reap the full benefits. Chouhan offered prayers at the Sri Lakshmi Narayani Golden Temple in Vellore. He inaugurated 'Gurusthanam Pooja Hall' in Vellore and participated in Maha Chandhi Havan for world peace. (PTI)

Himachal Cabinet decides to double terms of mayors, deputy mayors to 5 years

SHIMLA, OCT 26 /--/ The Himachal Pradesh Cabinet on Saturday decided to extend the terms of mayors and deputy mayors of municipal corporations from two-and-a-half years to five years. The decision will benefit the mayor and deputy mayor of Shimla Municipal Corporation, whose two-and-a-half-year term is expiring in November 2025. Briefing mediapersons here, Industries Minister Harshwardhan Chauhan said a two-and-a-half-year term was raising apprehensions of horse-trading and pointed out that the term in Panchayati Raj institutions is five years. The Cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu also gave a nod to

enhance the honorarium of 510 special police officers (SPOs), including 403 in tribal and 107 in non-tribal areas, by Rs 300 per month. It also accorded ex-post facto approval for enhancement of honorarium of Rs 500 per month of School Management Committee (SMC) teachers, including Trained Graduate Teachers (TGT), classical and vernacular teachers, Junior Basic Training (JBT) teachers, lecturers and diploma and primary education (DPEs), mid-day meal workers and part-time water carriers. Both the decisions would be implemented with effect from April 1, 2025, a statement issued here said. The Cabinet decided to

allow the Transport Department to grant permission for the conversion of 1,000 petrol and diesel taxis into electric vehicles with provision of 40 per cent subsidy under the Rajiv Gandhi Swarojgar Yojna. It approved the proposal to streamline the implementation and efficient monitoring mechanism of Prakritik Kheti Khushhal Kisan Yojna and Himachal Pradesh Crop Diversification Project (JICA-Phase-II). This mechanism will go a long way in fostering coherence between the departments concerned, besides ensuring efficient governance and execution under the flagship programmes of the projects. Further, the Cabinet decided to constitute a Cabinet sub-

committee, headed by Revenue Minister Jagat Singh Negi, to finalise the draft of Rural Area Development guidelines to be adopted by gram panchayats in the form of model by-laws to regulate construction activities in the rural areas. Rural Development Minister Anirudh Singh, Urban Development Minister Vikramaditya Singh and Town and Country Planning Minister Rajesh Dharamani will be the members of this Cabinet sub-committee. It gave its approval to include 19 games in the list of games which qualify meritorious sports persons for consideration for appointment to posts under the state government departments, boards and corporations.
