Launch ‘Naipunyam’ portal during CII Partnership Summit, Andhra Pradesh CM Chandrababu Naidu tells officials

The Chief Minister directed the officials to collaborate with the national and international institutions for skill enhancement and suggested that the ‘Naipunyam’ portal be designed in such a way it would help the unemployed youth who had not benefited from any government scheme in gainful employment. Officials told the Chief Minister that 1,44,000 people had secured employment through job fairs held so far across the State and that the portal was designed to use AI in order to help the candidates create resumes and provide job updates regularly via WhatsApp. The Chief Minister wanted industries and educational institutions to be linked through the portal, and said awareness should be created among colleges on industry trends, and the system should allow tracking of placements.
‘Encourage innovations’
Innovations at the school level should be enhanced through a tie-up with the Ratan Tata Innovation Hub (RTIH), Mr. Naidu said, adding that training in foreign languages should be provided to enable the youth tap opportunities overseas.

Justice Surya Kant appointed as the 53rd Chief Justice of India

He made history by directing that one-third of seats in Bar associations, including the Supreme Court Bar Association, be reserved for women. Justice Kant was part of the Bench that appointed a five-member committee headed by former Supreme Court judge Justice Indu Malhotra to probe the security breach during Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s 2022 Punjab visit, saying such matters required “a judicially trained mind”. He also upheld the One Rank-One Pension (OROP) scheme for defence forces, calling it constitutionally valid, and continues to hear petitions of women officers in the armed forces seeking parity in permanent commission. He was on the seven-judge bench that overruled the 1967 Aligarh Muslim University judgment, opening the way for reconsideration of the institution’s minority status. He was part of the Bench which heard the Pegasus spyware case and which appointed a panel of cyber experts to probe allegations of unlawful surveillance, famously stating that the state cannot get a “free pass under the guise of national security”.

Major mishap averted at Sangam Barrage in Nellore

members, 30 SDRF members, 100 police personnel, Krishnapatnam Port Patrol staff, Fire and Irrigation officials managed to bring the 35-tonne boat to the shores on Thursday morning. District Collector Himanshu Shukla, Superintendent of Police Ajitha Vejendla and other officials reached the spot and monitored the situation. The NDRF swimmers and other team members worked for about 12 hours to pull the boat out. The other two boats also were towed down to the shores by the rescue team. If the teams couldn’t control the boats that were swept away, there would have been massive destruction to the barrage and the low-lying areas would have been inundated. The Sangam Barrage was built with 85 gates and it is irrigating 3.85 lakh acres of fallow land in the district. If it was damaged, the water would have been wasted and farmers would have suffered losses in the coming season. As it serves as a bridge for the villages of Podalakur and Sangam, the traffic between these villages would have also disrupted if it was damaged, said the officials. Efforts appreciated
Lauding the efforts of the district administration on social media platform X, Minister for HRD, IT, Electronics and Communications and Real Time Governance Nara Lokesh posted: “Collector and SP made arrangements on a war-footing basis to remove the boat without causing any damage to the barrage. Hats off to your efforts in averting a major waterlogging with teamwork.”

the procurement continued — reportedly due to kickbacks and commissions. Later, Tamil Nadu-based A.R. Dairy won the ghee supply contract, but it too sourced the material from Bhole Baba, using Sri Vaishnavi Dairy in Tirupati as an intermediary. According to SIT, Appanna allegedly played a key role in awarding contracts to ineligible dairies. He was earlier interrogated for two days in June at the SIT office in Tirupati, after which he approached the state high court.

The high court granted a stay on the probe on July 10. However, following Supreme Court directions, the investigation resumed in late September. After two days of renewed questioning this week, the SIT officials arrested Appanna for non-cooperation and produced him before the ACB Court in Nellore on Wednesday night. With the arrest, speculation is rife that SIT may soon summon Subba Reddy himself for questioning regarding his role in the ghee procurement irregularities.

Will be guided by imperative to secure affordable energy: India on US sanctions on Russian oil companies

“Our position on the larger question of energy sourcing is well known. In this endeavor, we are guided by the imperative to secure affordable energy from diverse sources to meet the energy security needs of our 1.4 billion people.” Earlier this month, the US imposed sanctions on Russia’s top crude exporters, Rosneft and Lukoil, forcing Indian refiners to announce suspension of new purchases. This has led to disruption of India’s energy supply chain and raised concerns about costs. According to reports, following the US announcement of sanctions, an Indian oil tanker carrying Rosneft crude turned around in the Baltic Sea while en route to India. Russia has been a major supplier of crude oil to India, providing nearly a third of the country’s imports. According to US President Donald Trump and his administration, India’s purchase of Russian oil is helping to fund the Ukraine conflict. His administration has imposed 50 percent tariffs on India, including 25 percent for purchase of Russian oil. The tariffs are the highest imposed by the US on any country. The new US sanctions on the Russian oil companies come as India and the US are nearing finalisation of a mega trade deal, with both sides holding regular intensive talks.

pletely satisfied with the steps taken by the coalition government and the assistance provided.

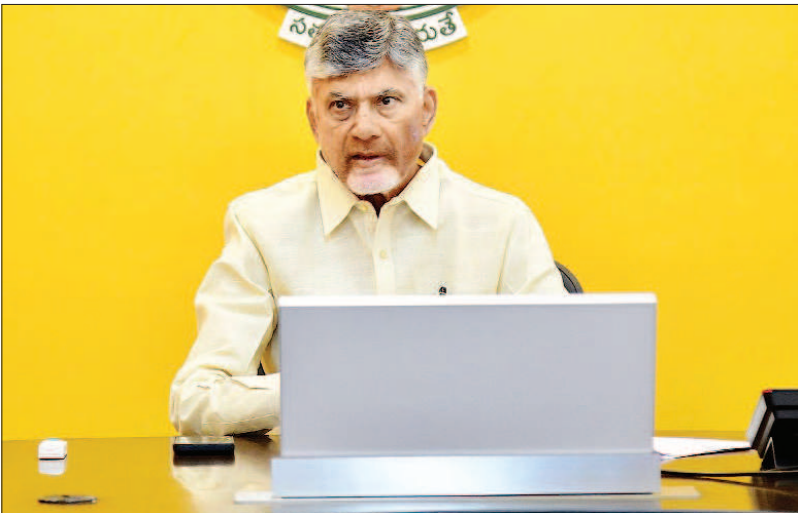

Tech-driven preparedness helped reduce cyclone impact, loss at Rs.5,265 crore, says Naidu

Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has said that the State government’s strategic use of technology, advance planning, and coordinated action among departments has greatly reduced the impact of Cyclone Montha, which, despite its severity, caused an estimated damage of Rs.5,265 crore across Andhra Pradesh. Addressing a media conference at the Secretariat on the cyclone’s impact and the government’s response on Thursday, Mr. Naidu said that the State was able to significantly reduce the scale of destruction through technology-driven preparedness and effective coordination among departments. “We were able to minimise the cyclone’s impact using advanced technology. All government departments worked in close coordination, and we managed to restore normalcy to a large extent on the very first day,” the Chief Minister said. He explained that satellite imagery and real-time data from the RTGS Data Lake enabled officials to predict rainfall intensity, wind speeds, and potential flood zones, facilitating timely warnings and preventive action. “In the past, recovery from cyclones would take over a week, but with better planning and technology, we reduced both loss of life and property,” Mr. Naidu observed. Referring to losses, the Chief Minister



said preliminary estimates indicate that Cyclone Montha caused damage worth around Rs.5,265 crore across Andhra Pradesh. Of this, losses in agriculture, horticulture, aquaculture, and roads were estimated at Rs.2,079 crore, while the power and water resources departments sustained a damage of about Rs.207 crore. A comprehensive report on the losses would be sent to the Central government shortly, he said. Mr. Naidu appreciated Ministers, officials, and people’s representatives, including coalition MPs and MLAs, for visiting affected areas and reassuring the public. He further noted that

Ministers Nara Lokesh and V. Anitha closely monitored the situation from the RTGS Command Centre, while field-level teams took swift action in coordination with district administrations. The Chief Minister added that technology was being used not only to monitor cyclone intensity but also to identify crop losses and inundated areas. Criticising those spreading misinformation online, he remarked, “Some people seem unhappy when the government uses technology to protect lives and prevent suffering. Their attitude is unfortunate.”
