

The country's first quantum computer is in Amaravati..

The cabinet has approved the implementation of 506 pending projects with a fund of Rs. 9,613 crore as part of AMRUT 2. He said that the proposals to call tenders for the construction of Lok Bhavan in Amaravati with a fund of Rs. 163 crore have been approved. He said that a decision has been taken by entrusting the responsibility of approving L1 bids to the CRDA Commissioner. He said that the responsibility of approving the L1 bid for the expansion of E 3 road in Amaravati has been entrusted to the Amaravati Development Corporation MD. He said that the proposal to increase the funds by Rs. 15.96 crore for the construction of a check dam on the Palar river in Kuppam, Chittoor district has been approved. He said that the cabinet has approved the proposal to upgrade 417 teacher posts in tribal welfare schools. He said that the cabinet has given its okay to the proposal to appoint people with experience in social service as chairmen and members in the social welfare department. He said that the key proposal has been approved in view of setting up the country's first quantum computer in Amaravati. He said that the state cabinet has approved an investment of Rs. 1421 crore in quantum computing. He said that the cabinet has approved the proposals to train 3057 people in quantum applications and provide jobs. Minister Parthasarathy said that the AP cabinet has given its approval to the proposals of 11 companies that came to invest in the quantum computing department. He said that the proposals of several companies that have come forward to manufacture quantum computers, as well as the proposals to provide training and job opportunities in quantum computing, have been approved. He said that the Cabinet has approved several investments taken in the recent SIPB meeting. He said that the Cabinet has given the green signal for investments of Rs 20267 crore in 14 companies across the state. He said that CM Chandrababu has taken it seriously to increase green energy production across the state. He said that the CM's goal is to bring down electricity charges from Rs 5.12 to

Rs 4. For this, he said that the Cabinet has approved the proposals of several companies for solar power production in the state. He said that 4731 acres of land were purchased in 2010 for the establishment of a multi-product SEZ at Krishnapatnam Port. The previous government canceled these land allocations in October 2019. He said that the cabinet decided to cancel the penalty as the project was delayed by ten years due to this being rejected by the court. He said that the decision was taken by giving time to start the construction of the first phase of the project in 3 years. He said that the cabinet decided to give an incentive to the state sportsperson Sri Charani, who showed exceptional talent in winning the Women's World Cup. Parthasarathy said that it has been decided to give Sri Charani a cash of Rs. 2.5 crore and a 500-yard house in Visakhapatnam. He said that the cabinet has approved the proposal to provide Group 1 jobs after graduation. He said that it has been decided to provide additional subsidy to BCs who install solar panels on their homes under PM Suryagarh. He said that the state government has decided to provide an additional subsidy of Rs. 20 thousand in addition to the subsidy provided by the center. He said that it has been decided to provide a subsidy of Rs. 20 thousand to BC consumers who consume up to 200 units of electricity. The minister said that the cabinet has decided to implement the PM Suryagarh project in the state with an estimated budget of Rs. 5445 crore. The CM said that people are facing difficulties in the state due to tampering of revenue records. He said that the CM has ordered the Revenue Department to completely resolve all revenue issues within a year. President Murmu to arrive in Hyderabad on Dec 17 for five-day southern sojourn

Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy reviewed the arrangements to be made for the President's five-day visit to the state with senior officials at the B.R. Ambedkar State Secretariat. The Chief Secretary directed the concerned officials to work in coordination and make extensive arrangements for the President's visit. He instructed the Central government departments, state government officials, and Rashtrapati Nilayam officials to coordinate the arrangements. He directed the police department to prepare a proper security, traffic, and bandobast plan; the fire

department to deploy necessary personnel and provide adequate fire safety arrangements and fire tenders; and the medical and health department to keep a medical team on standby.Chief Minister Revanth Reddy instructed the State Roads and Buildings Department to make necessary barricading and other arrangements, to carry out road repairs in coordination with Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) and the police department, and directed the electricity department officials to take appropriate measures to ensure uninterrupted power supply.

RS Chairman Radhakrishnan cautions members on limits of debate over election reforms

The Chair’s intervention came as members prepared to take part in a politically charged discussion.He repeatedly urged patience, asking members to allow the proceedings to begin in order.In response, Tiruchi Shiva questioned the interpretation of the rules. The members recalled a precedent set by a former Chairman, Jagdish Dhankhar, who had once ruled that “anything under the sky can be discussed in the House”.

ISRO to launch US’ BlueBird-6 satellite, weighing 6.5 tonnes, on Dec 15

US-licensed satellite, is scheduled to launch on December 15th from the Satish Dhawan Space Center in India,” the company said in a statement. “When launched, it will feature the largest commercial phased array in low Earth orbit at nearly 2,400 square feet. This represents a 3.5 times increase in size over BlueBirds 1-5 and supports 10 times the data capacity,” it added. This is the second collaboration between the US and ISRO. In July, the ISRO successfully launched the \$1.5 billion NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar Mission (NISAR), aimed at taking high-resolution Earth scans with a capacity to penetrate through fogs, dense clouds, and ice layers. “NISAR, launched on July 30, was jointly realised by NASA, JPL, and ISRO. It was the costliest satellite ever realised in the world, and was lifted off by the Indian

This will be the second visit of Prime Minister Modi to Oman. India and Oman share an all-encompassing Strategic Partnership underpinned by centuries-old bonds of friendship, trade linkages and strong people-to-people ties.
