Ahmedabad, According to a study by Ventura, portfolio exposure of small cap funds beyond the market cap rank of 1000—or microcaps—remains limited to ~2%. As of November 2025, the small-cap fund category manages ~73.7 lakh crore across 32 schemes. Allocation to small-caps is also skewed by perception. "Many stocks perceived as large- and mid-cap are actually small-cap stocks for fund managers as per AMFI classification," says Juzer Gabajiwal, Director at Ventura. For example, familiar companies—including CDSL,



Gillette, NBCC, PNB Housing Finance, Wockhardt, East India Hotels, Angel One, and Tata Chemicals—are officially classified as small caps even though investors often think of them as mid-cap-like. (13-9)
