Ahmedabad, Due to de-launching of girders on Bridge No. 114, a block will be undertaken between Saphale and Kelve Road as per the following schedule. 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The problem of ATM Frauds is global in nature and its ramifications have been felt in India as well. ATM Frauds in India are increasing at an alarming rate. If we add to it the cases of Credit Card Frauds, Internet Banking Frauds and frauds committed using Phishing techniques, the numbers are really shocking. With mobile phones being increasingly used for transactions, instances have been reported of fraudsters intercepting one-time passwords by obtaining duplicate SIM cards. The ATMs need to be highly secured as

cardholders are ignorant about such tricks. The Technology can also be used to minimize cases of ATM Frauds in India. Many write the PIN in the space provided for signature, and this is an open invitation to thieves. The security of the password need not be overemphasized with increasing thefts and frauds on the Internet. It is high time to revoke the Cyber Law of India as soon as possible and enact Strong and Effective Laws in this regard. Till we have suitable and apt laws, we must apply existing laws in a purposive and updating manner. IT raids on Lakshmi Diamond Group of Surat's Gajera family

Hawala network-real estate deals under investigation; Dhiru Gajera keeps indirectly targeting BJP

Surat Separate teams of more than 150 officers simultaneously raided the premises of Lakshmi Diamond Group across Gujarat.

The Income Tax Department has launched a comprehensive search operation on the 'Lakshmi Group', owned by the well-known industrialist Gajera family of Gujarat, since early morning today (January 28, 2026). Different teams of more than 150 officers have simultaneously raided the premises of this group, which has a big name in the diamond, education and real estate sectors, across Gujarat and started a vigorous investigation. Along with this, investigations are being conducted at the business premises, residential houses and various projects of Anil Bagdana and his partners Tarun Bhagat and Pravin Bhoot. Following this large-scale action, there has been a stir in the business and industrial world of Surat.

There was specific information and intelligence regarding the real estate deals of the group. Preparations for this operation were going on secretly for the last several days and the teams reached the designated locations early in the morning. The main focus of the investigation is all the transactions related to the real estate of the Lakshmi Group. The DDI wing of the Income Tax Department had specific information and intelligence regarding the real estate deals of this group in advance, based on which the documents are currently being verified.

members of the Gajera family. Questioning of all members of the family, including the main partners of the Gajera family Vasant Gajera, Chinu Gajera and Dhiru Gajera, and a deep investigation into their financial transactions has been started. In addition, the IT department has also extended the investigation into the latest 'hawala network' connections. For a long time now, Dhiru Gajera has been targeting BJP on social media.

This raid is also seeing political heat, because Dhiru Gajera of the Gajera family is known for his political leanings. After being in BJP earlier, he joined Congress and returned to BJP again. However, for the last few years, he has been in the news for indirectly targeting BJP leaders and activities on social media. In this situation, due to this action of the IT department, there has been a huge uproar in the entire industry and political circles.

family, Vasantbhai Gajera, migrated to Surat from Amreli. His father, a farmer by profession, gave him a capital of 10,000 to start this business. Vasantbhai, along with his two other brothers, Dhirubhai and Girdharbhai, started the business with just three diamond polishing wheels in a rented house in Surat. Then in the year 1972, the organization 'Lakshmi Diamond' was formally established. In the last 50 years, the company has grown from a small unit of the partnership of three brothers to a large group in the global diamond industry.

Dhiru Gajera's journey from corporator to MLA. Dhiru Gajera was born on October 14, 1953 in Mohpar village of Amreli. He is survived by his wife, son, daughter-in-law and grandson. His father Haribhai Gajera was a supporter of veteran politician Dwarkadas Patel and after witnessing political activities from a young age, he ventured into this field. Dhirubhai was elected as a municipal corporator in Surat in 1987 and then as an MLA in 1995.
